Randy Johnson – GMC Observer of basketball officials

- Be prepared. Know the rules. Hustle.
- Inbound spot of the throw in – don't be lazy. Do it right, put the ball in play by the book.
- Call what we see. Not what we anticipate.
- See the defense. See the play happen.
- Don't punish larger players that are in good defensive position

Difusers with coaches

- "If you have a question about a call, I'll be happy to answer"
- If you blew it and you know... change it. GET THE CALL RIGHT.
- Rapid Responses better than long discussions with coaches/players

Make sure your partners are ready before you put the ball in play

Video review of plays w/ Rick Henry

- End of game/qtr shots. Ensure we are in a good position. If you have information as a partner, come with it to the crew
- We can't use technology (unless at the state tournament) to review/change/confirm calls of any kind

East/Fairfield end of game intentional foul

- Important to maintain composure through the play and keep an eye on the players involved. Third official needs to keep wider view of the entire playing area and let partners work the point of foul

Georgetown/Mariemont ejection

- Reiterate how important it is for all officials to stay engaged and be alert. Poor dead ball officiating can make for a long night for the crew
